Submissions must be comprised of artwork created by an individual with a developmental disability and express what is important to and/or important for the individual. Artwork submitted by an organization; created at or during an event/activity held by an organization; bearing the name of an organization, product, or affiliation (unless the subject of the artwork); or that bears offensive subject matter will not be included in the exhibit.

By signing and submitting this application for entry, participants authorize IPMG to display their artwork in any and all of its publications and any and all other media, in addition to being displayed in community settings, whether now known or hereafter existing, controlled by IPMG, in perpetuity. Participants also agree to make no monetary or other claim against IPMG for the use of the piece, and even if the creator elects to have the piece returned to them, by signing below the creator indicates that they understand that images of his/her piece may still be used by IPMG. All artwork must be the original creation of the artist, and may, upon the request and authority of the artist, be submitted by a third party.
